At your request, we have completed the enclosed appraisal report for the purpose of establishing the replacement value comparable for the property contained herein for insurance purposes as requested. The effective date of valuation for the property is January 11, 2021. This appraisal report was prepared with the intended use of insurance coverage purposes only, and only you and your insurance provider are intended as the users of the information herein.

This appraisal has been prepared for a set and agreed upon fee. We have no undisclosed personal interest or bias with respect to these appraised items, which are the subject matter of this appraisal report, and we do not have any present or contemplated interest in the parties involved.

This appraisal is subject to the basic assumptions and limiting conditions contained herein and adheres to all of the standards of the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP) cited in the Bibliography of this report. We would also draw your attention to the Certification and Limiting Condition pages, and the Purpose and Procedures pages, which are important sections of this report.



Our scope of work for this assignment includes, but is not limited to, the proper inspection and identification of the property, the research and analysis of relevant markets, and the utilization of comparables of the subject property to reach a conclusion of **replacement value comparable**. **Replacement value comparable** is defined by the American Society of Appraisers in the *Appraisal of Personal Property* handbook as **the price in terms of cash or other precisely revealed terms that would be required to replace a property with another of similar age, quality, origin, appearance and condition within a reasonable length of time in an appropriate and relevant market** (2).

We prepared this report and reached our conclusion of value on unbiased and ethical standards put forth by the American Society of Appraisers and the 2015-2016 edition of USPAP published by the Appraisal Foundation.

The aggregate valuation conclusion based on replacement value for insurance coverage is: \$1,646,310.00 (One Million Six Hundred And Forty-Six Thousand Three Hundred And Ten Dollars and Zero Cents). We reached this conclusion of value based on knowledge of the highest and best use of the marketplace where these particular properties are most often traded, the most up to date sales of comparable properties, and our personal experience as professional appraisers. All characteristics that affect value were considered.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this appraisal is to estimate the replacement value comparable using the market comparison approach for the personal property of intended user John Smith.

FUNCTION: The function of this appraisal is to establish a basis for replacement value comparable, which includes comparisons with historical data, reported sales, offers to sell by catalog, and showroom or gallery pricing.

DEFINITION OF VALUE: The definition of replacement value comparable is the price in terms of cash or other precisely revealed terms that would be required to replace a property with another of similar age, quality, origin, appearance and condition within a reasonable length of time in an appropriate and relevant market (American Society of Appraisers, pg. 2).

INTENDED USE: The intended use of this appraisal is for insurance coverage. This report is intended for obtaining insurance coverage only. There are is not other intended use for this appraisal report.

INTENDED USER(S): The intended user(s) of this appraisal report is/are John Smith and their insurance company. There are no other intended users of this appraisal report.



PROCEDURES

The procedures outlined below are those that we generally consider appropriate to the circumstances of appraisals done for insurance purposes. Where these procedures have been varied, whether at the request of the client or because, in our judgment, other procedures were warranted in a particular instance, such variations are noted in the body of the report. Representatives of Asset Verification, Inc., are trained art historians who apply a rigorous standard of connoisseurship to the identification of works of fine and decorative art. OWNERSHIP

The client stated that he or she owned the property. The appraisal is not a certificate of the title or a warrant of ownership. Ownership was not researched or confirmed.



DEFINITIONS

The following are the definitions as stated in the *The Appraisal of Personal Property: Principles, Theories, and Practice Methods for the Professional Appraiser* (see Bibliography).

REPLACEMENT VALUE: The price in terms of cash or other precisely revealed terms that would be required to replace a property with another of similar age, quality, origin, appearance, and condition within a reasonable length of time in an appropriate and relevant market. Intangible provenance value is additive when appropriate. Because of the time element involved, the appropriate market for replacement is deemed to be that of primary sources, such as department stores, galleries, and shops carrying comparable and immediately available personal properties. If the only source for replacement can be demonstrated to be that of auction, that is the source utilized.

Replacement Value is used as the basis for insurance purpose and damage/loss reports.

FAIR MARKET VALUE: The price at which the property would change hands between a willing buyer and a willing seller, neither being under any compulsion to buy or sell and both having reasonable knowledge of relevant facts. Because auction sales are publicly recorded, these are the values deemed to be most appropriate in finding prices for properties in tax-related reports and in cases where dispersal of properties is involved. The fair market value assumption is that the value stated is the substantiated price (realized price) that would be paid by the buyer at auction for a comparable property. When there are no appropriate auction records to be used as comparables in determining a property's current value, the most common market for the item might also be deemed to be a source for verified replacement value for a comparable property sold through a primary source.

Fair Market Value is used as the basis for appraisals for charitable contributions, estate taxation, and equitable distribution.

MARKET VALUE: A price that is similar to Fair Market Value, but without the provision for lack of compulsion to buy or sell and with the addition of the need to sell within a specified time frame.

According to USPAP, Market Value is defined as the most probable price which a property should bring in a competitive and open market under all conditions requisite to a fair sale, the buyer and seller, each acting prudently, knowledgeably and assuming the price is not affected by undue stimulus.

Market Value is the agreed upon basis for value for specified cases and the rationale for use of this value must be stated in the appraisal.



LIQUIDATION VALUE: Forced Liquidation Value is the most probable price for which a property would change hands if sold immediately, without regard to relevant marketplace. This value would be used only under emergency conditions that require immediate liquidation. Orderly Liquidation Value is the probable price for which a property would change hands under limiting conditions in an orderly manner, generally advertised, with reasonable time constraints, and in an appropriate and relevant marketplace with knowledgeable buyers. This value may also be applied in cases where notice is given at higher level auction of the circumstances under which the properties are being sold.

VALUE IN USE: The value of property which reflects a value to a particular user, recognizing the extent to which the property contributes to the personal requirements of the owner. For example, the value of an antique podium in uninterrupted use by descendants of the item's original auction house owners would have more value to the current user than it would if placed on the general market.

ACTUAL CASH VALUE: The price in terms of cash or other precisely revealed terms that would be necessary to replace a property with another of similar age, quality, origin, appearance, size, and condition within a reasonable length of time in an appropriate and relevant market. This definition encompasses the concept of "as is" or "with" or "without" restoration.

Actual Cash Value is the market value of a property less all forms of depreciation.



APPROACHES TO VALUE

There are three approaches to value. The following are the definitions as stated in *The Appraisal of Personal Property: Principles, Theories, and Practice Methods for the Professional Appraiser* (see Bibliography).

COST APPROACH TO VALUE: Research and analysis of the cost of a substitute property with equivalent function and desirability, providing an estimate of the depreciated reproduction, reproduction new or replacement cost of the property. Cost Approach to Value estimates either reproduction or replacement of a property, either new or depreciated.

INCOME APPROACH TO VALUE: Research and analysis of the present worth of anticipated income. Income Approach to Value estimates the present worth of anticipated future benefits of owning income- producing properties or objects.

MARKET SALES APPROACH TO VALUE: Research and analysis comparing sales of property similar enough to the property being appraised to permit a detailed comparison, estimating value by comparison with properties sold in the relevant market, with adjustments made for all differences which affect value, such as differences in characteristics of value in time. Market Sales Comparison Approach to Value estimates value by comparison with properties sold in a relevant market with adjustments for all differences that affect value, in market layer, and in time exposed to the market in order to arrive at the most appropriate estimate of value.

All three approaches were considered in making the decision to use the market sales comparison approach as the most logical way to conclude a replacement value comparable.

The cost approach to value did not apply because there are an adequate amount of comparables in the market place for the subject properties without having to recreate them.

The income approach was not used as there are no possible forms of income that could be generated from the property and it is not being used as a source of income.







David FeBland started out not as a painter, but as an illustrator. His technique is gorgeously developed, but, as all technique should be, in perfect tandem with the content it most agreeably serves. Even so, FeBland is a direct descendant of the Boldiniesque tradition which seeks to wow the spectator with painterly moves. Yet FeBland's capacity to impress with bravura alone is held in check by his ability to hang out on a limb and strike at the heart of who we are and how we manage in urban environments that are out of step with human needs, yet irreducibly private. He has taken a brutally pre-emptive world and populated it, not with grinning lunatics, but people with urgent needs and obsessive yearnings.

In his earlier paintings, human connection appeared somewhat implausible, as pools of bright tarmac and smouldering red brick sloshed together. The FeBland of this recent show has found, if not love, then a certain amiable lubricity. His women are fully in possession of an earthy, albeit cosmetically enhanced, sexuality - reminiscent of the Venusian babes Reginald Marsh could do without trying. (FeBlands Redhead could be "High Yaller" in a better neighborhood.) His people are often elongated, exuding a wild energy that seems to be slightly ahead of them. Caught in the snags of our alienating infrastructures, they make ecstatic bids for affirmation even as they burrow into their private worlds. The quintessential FeBland figure is on a skateboard - fitting for a guy who'd been a bicycle messenger. But FeBland isn't always running around; he has lately discovered a strain of simple humanity that has been largely absent from his work in the past. His picture vendor (Laws of Physics) has given up, but is willing to go through the motions. In Path of Escape two Hasidic Jews stand before a high fence puzzling over a post-9/11 scenario. An enraptured luddite has taken "his last cassette" to an open field to admire its wind-borne destruction . FeBland's unflappable technique, however, goes a little haywire at times. In artists with smaller repertoires, it's easy to stick to tried-and-true formulas and keep on doing them at least indifferently. FeBland has to contend with such a well-tempered instrument that he sometimes has trouble reining it in. Subterranean, for all of its superficial graces, is evecandy. Kaaba is a kind of girly picture surrounded with wink/wink quotation marks. We understand that we might be in somewhere in the Middle East. On its sandy bosom a man prostrates himself as some possible Americans observe or try not to observe him. But the babes the focus of the thing and we have to decide whether we can live with her callous narcissism, which may be a stand-in for All of Us. FeBlands larger narrative paintings lack, as a whole, the intriguing ambiguity that sets his work apart from the illustrative chatter he has, for the most part, eschewed. The exception is Keystone, which shows a robbery in progress, with the thief only a few paces ahead of his well-heeled pursuers: the lady incredulous; her boyfriend hopping mad; the long-coated felon trying his damndest to get



away. You look at it and think somebody has taken that soft-focus picture of a sophisticated couple, fast-forwarded it a frame or two and - voila! - we have a situation! FeBland's claim to our minds and senses consists in his persistent willingness to take the old picture and run with it - run well past our conventional expectations toward a place where the rulebook is held up to ridicule after it has been consulted on a fine point of construction.



"I constantly search for the academics, emotion, expression, and at-the-moment character of a scene. Every painting should have a fine balance of these components. Toward that end, each piece develops its own unique personality." – C.W. Mundy

Charles Warren Mundy ranks among the most important American impressionists painting today. No matter the subject matter, be it a battle-scarred working fishing boat in Gloucester Harbor, a petite ballerina executing a graceful pas des deux, a delicate pink vase in a structured still life, or a moody English landscape, Mundy's aggressive, often soft-edged painterly style is very much his own.

Born in Indianapolis, Mundy received his undergraduate degree in art from Ball State University and his Masters of Fine Art at Long Beach State in Los Angeles.

Over the years he has received numerous awards from his participation in both regional and national juried exhibits, including the prestigious Hoosier Salon. He was awarded the honor of Signature Membership in Oil Painters of America in 1993. Most recently, his plein air landscapes done in France, Italy, Spain, New England and most recently, Martha's Vineyard, have received critical acclaim.

Mundy's work is displayed in the Indiana State Museum, Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art, Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame, The University of Louisville Hall of Fame, Indianapolis 500, as well as many private and corporate collections.

In 1994, Mundy left his successful career as an illustrator of sports figures and events to the more personally satisfying and challenging demands of painting en plein-air. Mundy immersed himself in the historic homeland of the Impressionists in his first painting trip to France in 1995. He captured the variable atmospherics of the traditional Impressionist haunts in an overcast morning, Pont Aven, Drizzling October Morning; the saturated sunset hues of Cote D'Azur, Port De Cannes, and the muted fog tones of Paris, Pont Neuf. These French works were the core of his first exhibition introducing his new style to the public and they were an unqualified success.

By 1997 Mundy's work was nationally recognized. He was awarded Best of Show in the Hoosier Salon and would be so honored in the 1998 and 2000 Salon. Art journals were taking critical notice of his work and he was the subject of major articles in Southwest Art and International Artist. His travels by 2000 included destinations in France, Italy, England, Spain, Eastern Europe and New England. Exhibitions of works from these travels continued to be very popular and more often than not were sell-outs.

Mundy's distinctive style of applying the paint to canvas continued to develop. His broader application of paint can be seen in the thick impasto and bravura brush strokes of Jeffersonville, Farm at Sterling Ridge and Steyr, View from the Café. Perhaps the hallmark of



Mundy's style is the use of the palette knife that scumbles and livens the surface with slashes and sweeps creating a distinctive textured veil over the image.

He received an MBA from Stanford University in Finance in 1975, and from 1975 to 1986 was Vice President of Corporate Banking for Citibank in Brazil and Spain. From 1986 to 1990, he was an International Financial Consultant in New York, Brazil, and Spain. In 1992, he began his serious pursuit of art by attending the New York Studio School in New York where he studied drawing and painting. In 1994, he earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from the Kansas City Art Institute majoring in sculpture. Furthering his art education, in 1997, he earned a Master of Art degree from the Royal College of Art in London, England, again focusing on sculpture. He began exhibiting his abstract bronze pieces, many with balancing figures, in Kansas City in 1992, and from that time has been a part of exhibitions in many places including Kansas, England, France, New Mexico, and Tennessee. Robert Philipp, painter and etcher was born February 2nd, 1895 in New York City. He studied at the Art Students' League with Frank Vincent DuMond and George Bridgman from 1910 to 1914. He also studied at the National Academy of Design with Volk and Maynard from 1914 to 1917. Philipp painted a wide range of subjects that included genre, portraits, Holland, Paris, bars, nudes, clowns, flowers and coasts. His style employed an often-unusual use of color that although different, seemed intriguing and appropriate to the composition. He favored subjects of leisure often depicting scenes such as ladies in a balcony enjoying a show, girls in interiors reading, a night out, a stroll in the park. Although often overlooked by art scholars today, Philipp was universally appreciated during his lifetime. He conveyed his subjects with a certain sensitivity and understanding that his viewers could relate to.



Drapery is by definition a panel, or panels, of fabric that covers the entire window, or is set up as non-operable stationary panels. These often feature some kind of pleated top, either stiff with buckram or soft without buckram, depending upon the style. This is true with custom AND ready made drapes.

Custom drapery can stand alone as a complete window treatment, or have added features like a drapery valance for effect. These headings might consist of pleats, again stiff or soft with the use of or without buckram. This, again, is true for both custom and ready-made-draperies. A distinct difference usually is in the drapery lining and drapery interlining. They are often used to give the fabric more body so it will drape into nicer folds, and provide a more luxurious look and feel to the panels.

GLOSSARY

ACANTHUS: A semi-stylized motif that occurs throughout the history of art, notable in the capitals of the Corinthian order of Greek architecture.

CARTOUCHE: A painted, engraved, or sculptured ornament of irregular or fantastical form, enclosing a plain central space, usually oval or lozenge-shaped, used as a field for inscriptions.

CLOISONNE: A kind of surface decoration in porcelain enamel on metal and rarely, on pottery, in which each color area is surrounded by a thin line of metal that is flushed with the enamel surface.

CONDITION: Unless stated otherwise, the property described in this report is considered to be "normal condition" and will contain no specific reference thereto. Specific reference will be made to superior conditions adding materially to the value, or to defects or damage adversely distracting from the value, as compared to similar works or objects in "normal condition".

DATED: Made around the date found on the subject.

FINIAL: In architecture, furniture, metalwork, and ceramics, an ornament that serves as the crowning detail, as the apex of a roof or gable or on the lid of a tankard or covered bowl that serves chiefly as decoration.

FLATWARE: Utensils or receptacles that are relatively flat, almost exclusively to pieces of metal, especially silver.

FLUTED: Closely spaced parallel or nearly parallel grooves, used to embellish moldings and other surfaces, commonly used in architecture and furniture for the decoration of columns and legs.

GILT: The art of adhering thin gold metal leaf to a surface to approximate the effect of solid or inlaid metal.

INLAY: To create a design or picture on a surface by inserting thin pieces of a material such as wood, metal, tile, stone shell, or ivory precisely in a series of shallow depressions or on a depressed ground, typically through techniques such as marquetry, mosaic, parquetry, damascene, intarsia, and pietra dura.

LIMITED EDITION: A set number of replicas of a work of art, of which the plate, mold, or die is destroyed or mutilated after the desired number of copies has been made.

MAJOLICA: An earthenware or faience of brownish-red body, decorated with heavily embossed, richly colored, glossy, opaque glazes.



ORMOLU: Gilded bronze or brass used as pure or functional decoration; literal French translation "ground gold".

PASTEL: A colored crayon that consists of pigment mixed with just enough of an aqueous binder such as gum tragacanth to hold it together and a work of art produced with such crayons; the technique itself.

PERIOD: The use of the term "period" implies that the article is contemporaneous to the design period or reign attributed to it. If the item was not made at that period, it will bear the word "style" as part of the description (see "style").

PRINT: Any one of multiple impressions made on paper from the same plate, block, stone, screen, transfer paper, or film negative; lithographs, etchings, engravings, woodcuts, etc.

RENAISSANCE: A comparatively brief by tremendously important period in Western European history and culture that followed the medieval era and produced the beginnings of modern thought.

ROCOCO: A style of art and interior decoration in the 18th century, especially in France during the reign of Louis XV.

SCULPTURE: The creation of three-dimensional of three-dimensional forms by carving, molding, or assembly in various mediums.

STYLE: The use of the term "style" implies that the article is an intentional copy of an earlier design, although it may still be considered antique by virtue of age. The terms "style" and "period" are mutually exclusive.
